January 9, 2019

The minutes of the November 28th, 2018 meeting were approved. Linda Bender moved to accept; Rodney Powell seconded.

The resignation of Board member Jimmie Van Valkenburg was announced. Members were asked to present nominations for a new member at the March meeting.

Evelyn Sanders announced that she had clarified with Wanda Parrish, the name of this committee was to be Tree City. Upon approval of the City Council, the name change takes place.

Arbor Day - The Beautification Board and the City of Gulf Shores Landscape Department will offer six trees for planting to residents on Saturday, February 23, 2019, in recognition of Alabama Arbor Day. A schedule of events was decided and Mark Acreman is to have this schedule on all publicity presented to the public.

Beautification Awards - Rodney Powell announced the recipients of the Christmas Decoration Award. Big Beach Brewery, Drunken Shrimp, and the neighborhood of Lora Point received recognition signs.
