**MINUTES OF
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA
FEBRAURY 28, 2022**

Mayor Robert Craft called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. at the Gulf Shores City Hall Council Chambers.

The invocation was delivered by Councilman Stephen E. Jones.

Upon roll call, the following officials answered "present": Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., Councilman Gary M. Sinak, Councilman Philip Harris, Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., Councilman Stephen E. Jones and Mayor Robert Craft.

Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. moved to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of February 14, 2022, as presented; seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr. "aye", Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

At this time, Councilman Philip Harris moved to approve the minutes of the Council Work Session Meeting of February 21, 2022, as presented; seconded by Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D.; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., "abstain", Councilman Gary M. Sinak, "aye", Councilman Philip Harris, "aye", Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D., "aye", Councilman Stephen E. Jones, "aye" and Mayor Robert Craft, "aye". Whereupon, Mayor Robert Craft declared the motion carried.

Councilman Stephen E. Jones moved to approve the expense vouchers in the amount of \$762,200.01 seconded by Councilman Gary M. Sinak; and the vote of those officials present was unanimously in favor of the motion.

The City Clerk noted that the complete list of vouchers to be paid, as reflected on a computer printout, had been made a permanent record in the Clerk's office.

Furthermore, Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D. moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

**A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A
GRANT AGREEMENT FOR FUNDING FROM THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF
ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT (ADEM) RECYCLING GRANT PROGRAM
FOR EQUIPMENT TO SUPPORT THE CITY'S RECYCLING CENTER
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$85,228.00**

WHEREAS, in 2014 the City of Gulf Shores established a recycling center located at 167 Parkway South, Gulf Shores, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gulf Shores received an ADEM Recycling Grant in 2015 which funded the initial start-up of the facility; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Gulf Place Revitalization Project and Leave Only Footprints Program are greatly enhanced by collection and proper disposal of recyclable materials in this high density beachfront area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON FEBRUARY 28, 2022 as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, a grant agreement with the Alabama Department of Environmental Management Recycling Grant Program for the purchase of equipment to enhance the City’s ongoing recycling efforts at the City Recycling Center in the amount of \$85,228.00 and further that any prior authorization and execution of said application is hereby ratified and approved; and

Section 2. That no City match is required.

Section 3. That the City of Gulf Shores understands that it will sign assurances to comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, rules and regulations.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE
MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AND ATTEST, RESPECTIVELY, AN
AMENDMENT TO THE CITY’S CONTRACT WITH ARCHITECTURE WORKS, LLP,
FOR ADDITIONAL DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE RESTORE-FUNDED
GULF COAST CENTER FOR ECOTOURISM & SUSTAINABILITY PROJECT
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,000**

WHEREAS, The City was awarded \$9.7M in RESTORE funding for the Gulf Coast Center for Ecotourism & Sustainability Project as part of the Alabama Gulf Coast Recovery Council’s Multi-Year Implementation Plan. Phase I (\$1,020,723) of the grant agreement is for planning, engineering, and design services for the project.

WHEREAS, in 2019 the City procured professional services from Architecture Works, LLP for engineering and design for \$949,320 by the passing of Resolution 6195-19. After several stakeholder design workshops as part of the preliminary planning and schematic design phases, it was determined that additional design services in the amount of \$65,000 would be necessary to meet the project goals. Council passed resolution 6315-20 on September 14, 2020 to amend the professional services contract with Architecture Works, LLP, in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.

WHEREAS, the plans were completed and submitted to ADCNR/U.S. Treasury for review in fall 2021, and U.S. Treasury has asked for additional documentation as part of the federal environmental checklist review. Funding for this additional work is budgeted in Phase I of the grant agreement.

WHEREAS, the amended contract will replace Architecture Works, LLP’s previous contract to add additional design services identified as necessary through the planning and schematic design phases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON FEBRUARY 28, 2022, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, a contract between the City of Gulf Shores and Architecture Works, LLP for additional design services identified as necessary through the planning and schematic design phases; in substantially the form presented to Council this date.

Section 2. That this amendment will bring the final cost of design services for the project to \$1,019,320. \$5,550,000 was budgeted as a receivable in FY2022 for design and construction for this project. **Costs for this project will be 100% reimbursed through the RESTORE grant.**

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

After a brief discussion between members of the council, Mayor Craft opened the floor for public comments. With no comments from meeting attendees, Councilman Gary M. Sinak introduced and moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

**A RESOLUTION
GIVING PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE PENDING CONSIDERATION OF THE AMENDMENT OF
THE ZONING ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF GULF SHORES RELATING TO TOWNHOUSES
AND TO CERTAIN MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS AND OF THE TEMPORARY SUSPENSION
OF ACCEPTANCE OF SITE PLAN REVIEW APPLICATIONS FOR AFFECTED PROJECTS**

WHEREAS, after analysis of the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance for the City of Gulf Shores and after receiving stakeholder input, the planning staff of the City of Gulf Shores has advised the City Council of the need for the consideration of certain changes to Section 11-3 of the Zoning Ordinance for the City of Gulf Shores relating to Townhouses, to Table 7-1A relating to the use regulations applicable to Townhouses in Districts R-3 and R-4, to Use Regulations For Non-Residential Districts applicable to Townhouses in Districts BN, BG, BG-1FM, BG-2FM, ICW-N, and ICW-S, to Section 11-21 of the Zoning Ordinance for the City of Gulf Shores relating to Multiple-family Dwellings, to the use regulations applicable to Multi-family Dwellings in Districts BN, BG-1FM, BG-2FM, ICW-N and ICW-S, and to the area and dimensional regulations applicable to Multi-family Dwellings in Districts R-3, R-4, BN, BG-1FM, BG-2FM, ICW-N, and ICW-S, all of which would have an impact on the development of land within such Zoning Districts; and,

WHEREAS, The City Council desires to have the recommendations of the planning staff expeditiously developed and presented to the Planning Commission for preparation of a preliminary report, conduct of a public hearing, and submission of a final report to the Council pursuant to Section 3-6 of the Zoning Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to take action on the proposed amendments after receipt of the report of the Planning Commission and, if the City Council determines that consideration of enactment of some or all of the amendments should be undertaken, to cause the publication of the proposed amendments and to conduct a public hearing thereon as provided in Section 3-7 of the Zoning Ordinance, all such actions intended to occur within 90 days of the date of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to place all interested parties on notice that it intends that any amendment to the Zoning Ordinance adopted with respect to Section 11-3 of the Zoning Ordinance for the City of Gulf Shores relating to Townhouses, with respect to Table 7-1A relating to the use regulations applicable to Townhouses in Districts R-3 and R-4, with respect to Use Regulations For Non-Residential Districts applicable to Townhouses in Districts BN, BG, BG-1FM, BG-2FM, ICW-N, and ICW-S, to Section 11-21 of the Zoning Ordinance for the City of Gulf Shores relating to Multiple-family Dwellings, to the use regulations applicable to Multi-family Dwellings in Districts BN, BG-1FM, BG-2FM, ICW-N and ICW-S, and to the area and dimensional regulations applicable to Multi-family Dwellings in Districts R-3, R-4, BN, BG-1FM, BG-2FM, ICW-N, and ICW-S, will be adopted with an effective date retroactive to the date of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that no application for site plan review of any Townhouse or Multiple-family Dwelling project proposed to be located within the City of Gulf Shores will be accepted for processing by the Community Development Department prior to the date of action by the City Council on the proposed amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON FEBRUARY 28, 2022, as follows:

Section 1. The planning staff of the City of Gulf Shores is directed to finalize its proposed changes to Section 11-3 of the Zoning Ordinance for the City of Gulf Shores relating to Townhouses, to Table 7-1A relating to the use regulations applicable to Townhouses in Districts R-3 and R-4, to Use Regulations For Non-Residential Districts applicable to Townhouses in Districts BN, BG, BG-1FM, BG-2FM, ICW-N, and ICW-S, to Section 11-21 of the Zoning Ordinance for the City of Gulf Shores relating to Multiple-family Dwellings, to the use regulations applicable to Multi-family Dwellings in Districts BN, BG-1FM, BG-2FM, ICW-N, and ICW-S, and to the area and dimensional regulations applicable to Multi-family Dwellings in

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Districts R-3, R-4, BN, BG-1FM, BG-2FM, ICW-N, and ICW-S, and to present those proposals to the Planning Commission for preparation of a preliminary report, conduct of a public hearing, and submission of a final report to the Council as expeditiously as possible.

Section 2. City staff shall provide a copy of this Resolution to any person desiring to file an application for site plan review of any Townhouse or Multiple-family Dwelling project proposed to be located within the City of Gulf Shores and advise such person that amendments to the Zoning Ordinance that may affect such projects are under consideration and may be adopted and, if adopted, will be adopted with an effective date retroactive to the date of this Resolution. No application for site plan review of any Townhouse or Multiple-family Dwelling project proposed to be located within the City of Gulf Shores will be accepted for processing by the Community Development Department prior to the date of action by the City Council on the proposed amendments; or until 180 days from the adoption of this Resolution has elapsed whichever first occurs.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

The motion for the adoption of Resolution No. 6519-22 was seconded by Councilman Jason Dyken, M.D.; was regularly put; was discussed and considered in full by the Council; and upon the question, the vote thereon was as follows: Councilman Joe Garris, Jr., “aye”, Councilman Gary M. Sinak, “aye”, Councilman Philip Harris, aye”, Councilman Jason Dyken, “aye”, Councilman Stephen E. Jones, “aye” and Mayor Robert Craft, “aye”. 

Mayor Robert Craft declared the meeting adjourned at 4:40 p.m.

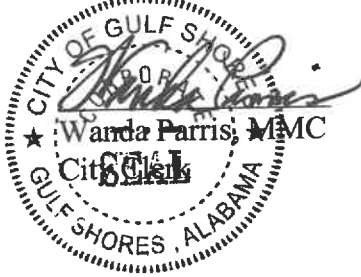
