Please take note of the following City closures in honor of Martin Luther King Jr. Day:

- Administrative offices for the City of Gulf Shores will be closed on Monday, January 16. Regular operations will resume on Tuesday January 17.
- Police, fire, and other emergency services will remain open to ensure public safety and health.
- The regularly scheduled City Council Work Session (Committee of the Whole) meeting has been rescheduled for Tuesday, January 17, at 4 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.
- The City Store will be closed Monday, January 16, and will resume regular operations on Tuesday, January 17.
- The Thomas B. Norton Public Library and the Gulf Shores Museum will be closed Monday, January 16. Regular operations for the library and museum will resume on Tuesday, January 17.
- The Bodenhamer Recreation Center will be open on January 16 from 5:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- The George C. Meyer Tennis Center will be closed on January 16. Courts will be open and available for public use. Regular operation hours will resume on Tuesday, January 17.
- The Cultural Center will be closed on January 16. Regular operations will resume on Tuesday, January 17.
- The Pickleball Courts located at the Gulf Shores Sportsplex (19025 Oak Road West) will remain open and available for play.
- Republic Services Garbage and Recycling Services will run as scheduled. Yard debris/bulky pickup will run as scheduled.
