Mardi Gras Parade traffic modifications and detours

Gulf Shores, Ala – February 27, 2017 – The City of Gulf Shores would like to make all residents and visitors aware of the following traffic flow modifications related to the Mardi Gras Parade on February 28 at 10 a.m.

6 a.m.

- East Gulf Place will be closed. West Gulf Place will be open for parking and through traffic.

9:30 a.m.

- Highway 59 will close to all traffic south of 20th Avenue. Traffic headed eastbound should take E. 20th Avenue to connect with Canal Road or Hwy 135 through Gulf State Park.
- All entrances onto Highway 59 between 19th Avenue and Highway 182 will be closed to **all** traffic until the completion of the parade.

11 a.m.

- All normal traffic conditions should resume along Highway 59. Highway 182 will reopen to eastbound traffic.

If severe weather moves in and the parade is cancelled, there will be no make-up date.
