**Gulf Shores Christmas Parade detours, traffic modifications**

Gulf Shores, Ala – November 28, 2017 – The City of Gulf Shores would like to make all residents and visitors aware of the following traffic flow modifications related to the Gulf Shores Lighted Christmas Parade and Holiday Celebration on Friday, December 1<sup>st</sup>.

Due to construction at Gulf Shores Public Beach, the parade route will be reversed this year. At 6:30 p.m. entries will make their way from the Gulf Shores Public Beach to West 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The parade will end with a celebration at Johnnie Sims Park.

**Road Closure Schedule**

**6:00 p.m.**

- Highway 59 will close to all traffic south of 20th Avenue. Traffic headed eastbound should take E. 20th Avenue to connect with Canal Road or Highway 135 through Gulf State Park.
- All entrances onto Highway 59 between 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Highway 182 will be closed to **all** traffic until the completion of the parade.

**8 p.m.**

- All normal traffic conditions will resume along Highway 59. Highway 182 will reopen to eastbound traffic.
